What to expect	What you can do
 The correct production of most speech sounds is expected Speech Intelligibility should be greater than 90% intelligible Errors may still exist on more difficult sounds: 'j', 'z', 'r', 'v', 'th' 	 Model the correct production to your child Encourage your child to self correct their error- help them identify their mistake and model the "fixed" word for them, e.g. "sebra", recasted for your child as "zebra" Help them understand the importance of using the right sound and how this helps others understand them
